Purpose of the Framework Agreement:

**1. The participating partner institutions divide into equal shares the co-funding contribution (20% of the total equipment value) to the project:**

**The Institute of parallel data processing is exempt but it takes the responsibility for the exploitation activities associated with the computer system.**

**2. In case additional participants are interested in signing the agreement, the latter must put in the respective installment of the above mentioned co-funding sum.**

**3. The partners are obliged to ensure free access of the Consortium members to the computational resources. User rates for external users will be worked out.**

**4. Decisions concerning the activities of the Computer system will be taken with consensus by the consortium members.**

**5. The present framework agreement is valid for indefinite term and can be suspended in case of physical incapacity of the computing facilities.**

**6. Exit of a partner from the framework agreement requires a preliminary notice a month in advance and completion of all financial and other duties ensuing from this agreement.**

**7. The agreement takes power on the date of approval of the launching of the Computational system in regular exploitation.**
